Professor Grzegorz W. Kolodko: a renowned economist and a world expert on transition and development policy. In 1989 he was participating in the historical Polish Round Table, which led to the first post-communist government in East Central Europe. In 1989-91 he was member of the Economic Council of the Government. He held positions of Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Finance four times between 1994 and 2003, under four different Prime Ministers. While Deputy Premier and Minister of Finance (1994-97) he led Poland to the OECD. Holding the same positions again in 2002-03 he played an important role in Poland's integration with the European Union. He is a consultant for the International Monetary Fund, the World Bank, United Nations and OECD.

A graduate and Ph.D. of Warsaw School of Economics, he is currently Director of TIGER - Transformation, Integration and Globalization Economic Research and professor at the Leon Kozminski Academy of Entrepreneurship and Management in Warsaw. He was visiting professor at Yale, UCLA and the University of Rochester, New York, as well as research fellow and lecturer at academic institutions and organizations worldwide. He authored 35 books and over 300 scientific articles in the area of economics.
